5. Please no sandals or flip flops around the horses.
6. No one is allowed to ride unless they sign a liability release.
7. Personal pets are highly discouraged, however, if present, all pets must be leashed or left in your vehicle. Barking and/or out of control dogs will be asked to leave.
8. Owner will not be held responsible for any injury, accident and/or death associated with using tack in ill repair.
9. The indoor arena and round pen are available to everyone for their use but please be courteous to other riders when using them.

- At stop sign, turn right on North Tolles Rd. for 0.5 mi.
- At stop sign turn left on West County Rd. M for 0.5 mi.
- Take the first left onto North Berg Rd (dead end)
- Travel to the end of the road and take the gravel road to the right at the mobile home.

From Janesville:

- From intersection of Highway 51 and Highway 14 head west on US Highway 14 for approximately 10.5 miles.
- Turn right onto North Wilder Road for 2.5 miles.
- At second stop sign, turn left on West County Road M for 0.5 mi.
- Take the first right onto North Berg Rd (dead end).
- Travel to the end of the road and take the gravel road to the right at the mobile home.
